Evaluation Report – 2nd Transnational Project Meeting (Germany)

- Project: Water Skyball in Europe – Training of Trainers (WSB in EU – ToT)
- Project Number: 101134194
- Event: 2nd Transnational Project Meeting with Practical Educational Events and Amateur WSB Championship
- Venue: Germany

Summary:

The second Transnational Project Meeting was successfully held in Germany, focusing on the further development of Water Skyball coaching competencies and practical applications of the sport in different environments. The event built on the achievements of the first meeting in Hungary and provided an opportunity for partners to deepen their professional collaboration.

Key Results:

- Participants improved their coaching skills and shared best practices for training delivery.
- Practical sessions supported knowledge transfer and adaptation of training materials to local needs.
- The Amateur Water Skyball Cup demonstrated the sport's inclusiveness and recreational potential.
- Stronger cooperation was established between partner organizations for upcoming project phases.

Main Outcomes:

- Increased motivation among trainers to integrate WSB activities into their national sport programs.
- Strengthened international community and exchange of ideas.
